

**Notification Regarding RFP #2011:39:

The above Offerors should be aware that individual negotiations will more clearly identify the exact school communities to be served, level of funding and other potential adjustments to their original proposal. A copy of your last audit or review must be submitted prior to signing a contract.

Offerors who were not selected have five business days in which to file a protest regarding the procurement procedure. Protests must state the reason for filing the protest which must relate to the procurement process. The protest must be received in writing on official agency letterhead by 4:00 p.m. on July 26, 2011. The letter must state the reason for the protest. A protest which is filed simply to request reconsideration of the procurement decision will not be considered. The protest may be hand-delivered or mailed to:
